1. Promotion tour through Germany

Professor Arkadiy Makarov promotes in January 2015 the 6th international scientific and technical conference. Especially therefore he travels with a group of students to technical University of Dortmund to participate to the PESS. Timofey, Tatyana and further students presented their results and basic researches. Professor Makarov invited students from Germany and Europe. His special theme of the Ferro resonance of a voltage instrument transformer in Russian substations impressed me. This investigation shows that in Russia the University collaborates on a high level (electrical fundamentals, equipment, and knowledge and simulation software). With these experiences I informed other colleagues form the University of Applied Science Coburg to participate to the 6th international scientific and technical conference 2015 in Ivanovo. 2. Invitation and call of papers

The invitation was the standard procedure. With email, internet and a web based platform a good information access was implemented. Also the well prepared time schedule shows all necessary dates. Especially for the paper preparation the uploaded templates was helpful.

3. Submission and review

During the abstract acceptance and the submission approximately 3 month for the preparation of the paper was scheduled. The upload was easy no problems occurred.

The paper was reviewed by scientists and professors. The procedure is also the normal state for contributions and publications. The time between the review and the submission of the final paper version was short but enough.

4. Invitation and VISA application

European citizen must applicate a VISA for the travel to Russia, therefore you need an invitation with the date of you stay to Russia, a valid passport, a health insurance over 30'000 € a biometric portrait photo. The VISA has to implement in your passport. The best way to get a VISA is to use the service of the VISA application centers. At first you have to fill an application (https://visa.kdmid.ru), send your documents to the VISA application center (http://www.vhs-germany.com/). The entire procedure takes approximately 3 weeks from start to receiving of the VISA.

5. Journey to Russia/Ivanovo

The journey to Russia was a great experience. Our travel started in Germany to Moscow by airplane. The trip to Ivanovo started from the train station Yarloslavskaya (Ярославская) to Ivanovo by overnight train. In Ivanovo we were fetched by students and taxi. It is also possible to travel by autobus from Moscow to Ivanovo.

6. Hospitality

Everything was well prepared, the conference, the documents, and schedules. For the non-russian-speaking people all necessary information was provided in English. Furthermore the transport to the hotel and University was well organized. During the conference session student joined us to translate all important information. The company of the scientists, student and colleagues make everything comfortable for us.

7. University and scientific

The Ivanovo State Power Engineering University has 7000 students and every year 240 students passes the high voltage technology each year. The different faculties allow a wide range of scientific width. The oral presentations are indicators for the high level of education on the University of Ivanovo. Especially for my presentation a student joined me to translate my speech in real time. The Professors and students take the preparation of my presentation serious to guarantee a high level speech and presentation.
